FOD Prevention Program Mission

Air Safety's FOD Prevention Program mission is to raise awareness at all FedEx Express ramps through presentations, equipment testing and distribution, training, and communications.



What is the Air Safety FOD Prevention Program doing for the FedEx Ramps?

- → Air Safety tests and promotes a FOD*BOSS™ Testing Program.
- Air Safety promotes an annual International FOD Awareness Poster Contest.
- → Air Safety annually distributes FOD Awareness Posters.
- → Air Safety provides annual metrics of FOD damages for the FedEx Ramps and Maintenance.
- → Air Safety periodically posts FOD Prevention information to various venues.



FOD*BOSS™ Testing Program

→ Air Safety tests and promotes the use of the FOD*BOSS™ Sweeping Unit by visiting FedEx Ramps, training employees to use the FOD*BOSS™, and presenting FOD Awareness to encourage participation in the FOD*BOSS™ Testing Program.





What is the FOD*BOSS?

- → The FOD*BOSS™ Rapid Response Airfield Sweeper sweeps up FOD diligently and has the ability to aid in the prevention of Foreign Object Damage to vulnerable jet engines.
- →Among the items the FOD*BOSSTM can pick up are nuts and bolts, washers, rivets, pieces of concrete and stones, sand, and empty drink containers.
- This efficient piece of equipment improved the FedEx Express sweeping operation by picking up most of the debris in a fraction of the time of a FOD walk.



AIR SAFETY'S FOD*BOSS PROGRAM

MEM Ramp FOD*BOSS Testing

- → The FOD*BOSS™ Testing Program started in May 2004.
- Air Safety follows up with the Ramp Managers frequently during the first 6 months through weekly feedback, then periodically over the next several years.
- → Air Safety has placed a total of 41 FOD*BOSS™ units on 38 FedEx Ramps (3 Ramps have received replacement units).
- → FedEx Express Ramps with FOD*BOSS[™] equipment are rapidly growing at a rate of 10 per year.



FOD Awareness Poster Contest Program

- → Air Safety promotes an annual International FOD Awareness Poster Contest.
- → Participants include FedEx Express Ramp and Air Operations employees.

Distribution of annual FOD Awareness Posters


→ Air Safety distributes the winning FOD Awareness Poster to all FedEx Domestic and International Ramps annually.
